Los Lonely Boys to Rock Post-Race Concert

"Texas Soul meets Rock 'n' Roll" at second annual Rock 'n' Roll San Antonio

San Antonio, TX (September 24, 2009) – The Texas trio Los Lonely Boys will rock the Alamodome at the second annual Rock 'n' Roll San Antonio Marathon & ½ Marathon post-race concert, which will take place on Sunday night, November 15. Last year, after selling out with 30,000 registered participants, the San Antonio Rock 'n' Roll event officially became the largest marathon and half marathon in Texas history. This year the race is again on target to sell out, and prospective runners are encouraged to register now before the race reaches capacity.

"We are excited to present Los Lonely Boys at the post-race concert," said Lucy Diaz, Event Manager. "The group's Texas roots and eclectic music style will appeal to runners travelling from all over the country, as well as the local community here in San Antonio."

Concert doors will open at 6:00 pm, with an awards ceremony at 6:30 pm. The music begins at 7:00 pm. (concert times are subject to change). Additional concert tickets can be purchased for \$25 online at the Rock 'n' Roll San Antonio website, at the Alamodome box office or at the Health & Fitness Expo on November 13 and 14 for \$30. All race participants and volunteers receive free entry into the concert.

Forming Los Lonely Boys when they were teenagers, the Garza brothers -- Henry, Jojo and Ringo -- have just released their third album, which they believe represents “familia” and “true American spirit – or Texican spirit.”

The bands first two studio albums (multi-platinum 2003 debut, Los Lonely Boys, and 2006’s *Sacred*, a no. 2 arrival on the Billboard albums chart), solidified Los Lonely Boys place in the Rock genre. The group’s hit single, “Heaven”, reached #1 on the Adult Contemporary chart, #16 on the Billboard Hot 100 and in 2005 the song earned a Grammy Award for Best Pop Performance with Vocal. Powered by passion and true brotherly love, their third album, *Forgiven*, is in every note, a rock ‘n’ roll classic.
